National Poll on Children's Health

Questions were answered by parents with a child age 5-17.

Q1. Parents often have questions about their child's behavior or emotions. In some situations, parents will talk with the child's doctor about something they notice about their child's behavior or emotions.

1. Has been extremely sad for over a month
