Questions answered by parents with a child age 13-17.

*Adderall, Ritalin and Concerta are stimulants that are often prescribed for those with ADD/ADHD. These pills are sometimes called "study drugs" because they are used by students without ADD/ADHD to stay awake and alert for long periods of time.*
